Effective March 1st, 2017, the Catholic Diocese of Jackson will make available on a <u>voluntary</u> basis to eligible members and dependents a new, cost saving, <u>international mail order drug program</u> for <u>brand name prescriptions</u>. **CDJScripts** is a voluntary program and does not replace your current prescription benefit plan.

Advantages of joining the CDJScripts program are:

- \$0 COPAY for all prescriptions offered through the program
- Prescriptions shipped directly to your home with no shipping and handling costs
- No out-of-pocket expenses
- See attached list of brand name prescription medications available

How does it work?

- Review enclosed formulary list of brand name prescriptions to determine if any of your current medications are available through this program
- Before ordering through the <u>CDJScripts</u> program, you or your doctor must attest that you have been taking your prescribed medication for at least 30 days - this is to ensure you have not experienced any complications with the medication
- Ask your doctor for a prescription for a 3-month supply with 3 refills
- Request your doctor to fax your enrollment form and prescription directly to <u>CDJScripts</u>
 -OR-

Mail your original prescription and completed enrollment form to CDJScripts

- Include a new prescription for each medication being ordered
- A representative will call you prior to each refill to ensure that you have a continuous supply of medications
- Allow 4 weeks for delivery when ordering new medications
